EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: Tools required for individual trade

MATERIAL REQUIRED: Materials for individual trade

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Steel-toed boots, hard hat, fall protection (harness, lanyard, tie off point)

JOB STEPS:

- 1. When working in or near shafts the following OH&S legislation must be followed.
 - a. There must be a main work platform that is completely decked and designed to support any anticipated load and a second platform not more than 4 meters below the main platform OR
 - b. If there is no platform, the doorway must be enclosed not less than 2 meters high and at least one warning sign indicating an open shaft is present.
- 2. There must be a site specific fall protection plan developed when the shaft is open to workers.
- 3. There must a site specific recuse plan developed as well.
- 4. All DVS workers must be educated to the fall protection and rescue plans and must sign off on the plan.
- 5. It is the responsibility of all workers, Supervisors and Builders to adhere to this legislation regardless of job.
