3.27 SAFE USE OF VEHICLES

Safe Work Practices:

- 1. Operator must have a current and valid license for each vehicle used.
- 2. Operator must be properly insured through DVS and must provide an abstract when requested.
- Operator must have knowledge of Bill 16 as well as general Alberta Motor Vehicle guidelines.

Procedures:

- 1. Ensure you walk around your vehicle to find any hazards that are visible.
- 2. Check your lights and tires prior to driving to ensure in good working order.
- 3. Ensure you have an insurance and registration card in the vehicle.
- 4. Always follow safe driving practices including not using you cell phone while you drive.
- 5. Adjust your mirrors and ensure you can safely see around your vehicle.
- 6. When backing out, if your vision is obstructed, ask for assistance from a co-worker or passer-by.
- 7. Should you find any issues with the vehicle itself, ensure you advise the vehicle coordinator (Robert Paxton).
- 8. You must complete a monthly inspection and hand it into the vehicle coordinator. This inspection must be completed properly by doing a walk around and ensuring everything is functioning properly.
- 9. When weather conditions are poor, drive accordingly by leaving extra room between the vehicle in front of you.
- 10. Always signal when changing lanes and complete a shoulder check in case of blind spots.
- 11. Be a courteous and professional driver, you are driving a billboard.
- 12. Drivers of 11,000Kgs or over must complete daily trip inspections as per the Alberta Transportation Board.
- 13. Any tickets received by a driver whether in company vehicles or personal vehicles, must be disclosed to DVS for insurance purposes.
- 14. Keep a safety kit in the vehicle in case of emergencies.
