## 3.12 SAFE USE OF PORTABLE CEMENT MIXERS

## **Safe Work Practices:**

- 1. Ensure workers using equipment have reviewed manual or have been instructed on proper use.
- 2. Ensure all equipment is maintained regularly according to operating guidelines.
- 3. Do not wear loose clothing/jewelry and contain long hair in order to avoid these items getting caught in moving parts.
- 4. Ensure all workers and bystanders working in the area wear the proper P.P.E in accordance with the standard nature of work. ie: safety goggles, dust mask, ear plugs, non-slip shoes and when appropriate hard hats to prevent injury.
- 5. Ensure appropriate electrical cords, with polarized plugs, are used.
- 6. Do not expose equipment to rain or wet conditions in order to avoid shock.
- 7. Equipment should be locked up to ensure it is not accessible by untrained individuals.

## **Procedures:**

- 1. Ensure you are appropriately dressed and equipped with P.P.E.
- 2. Before starting the mixer, check all guards are in position and correctly fitted.
- 3. Do not tip mixer onto drum mouth when the motor is running.
- 4. Ensure the trailing cord is protected against damage and not liable to be tripped over or trapped underneath the mixer.
- 5. Ensure the working area is clean and unobstructed to avoid someone tripping and falling into equipment.
- 6. Always make sure mixer is on level ground before starting to mix.
- 7. Become familiar with the controls and emergency shut off on the machine before mixing.
- 8. Inspect equipment and replace any worn/damaged parts and warning decals.
- 9. Ensure the drum is rotating when filling and emptying the drum.
- 10. Do not use as a wheel barrel; disconnect power source before moving.
- 11. Do not clean mixer onto the ground when in existing residential areas.
