EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: Ladders, scaffold, steel planks, stilts, sawhorses, taping tools – pan, knives, mixer (drill & whip), pole sander, bazooka, super taper

MATERIAL REQUIRED: Drywall fillers, joint tape, corner bead

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Steel toed boots, dust masks, hard hat

JOB STEPS:

- 1. Benches must be fully extended to the locked position when in use. Keep bench ladders regularly scraped and washed for proper use and inspection.
- 2. Apply joint tape and corner beads throughout house.
- 3. Coat all joints and beads.
- 4. Sand all joints and beads wearing dust masks.
- 5. Coat all joints and beads again.
- 6. Sand all joints and beads again wearing dust masks.
- 7. Apply finish coat.
- 8. When setting scaffold, all safety braces must be installed correctly and planks set safely and properly on scaffold. (planks are 12 to 14" wide).
- 9. Scaffold must be red tagged at the end of each day to prevent others from climbing on it.
- 10. All tools and hands must be washed thoroughly to remove debris and possible contaminated materials.
- Do not eat any foods with taping filler on hands as it could be contaminated and should not be digested.
- 12. Eye wash bottles are strongly suggested for tapers due to the amount of dust produced by this scope of work.
